Stoma friendly toilets- Sian advised she has been invited to a meeting at T&W CCG.

Prostate cancer- The group discussed the use of MRI scans as part of the pre diagnostic pathway. Roger confirmed that Prostate UK are now recommending an MRI scan prior to biopsy. The risks of biopsies were discussed. It was agreed that Roger would approach the urology consultants to invite them to a meeting to discuss.

Digital Health- Rob advised prostate patients are now being recruited via two GP practices, Stirchley in Telford and the Beeches in Shrewsbury. The expected number of breast patients signing up is lower than expected.
